Informational Meeting
Wednesday, February 22, 2012

Meeting called to order by Chair Chris Tormey at 6:07 p.m. in the Cabot School Library.

An overview of the budgeting process and tax implications was given by Chris with additional comments by other board members and attending staff.

Questions by the public in attendance included:

1. What is the plan for the facilities?
2. What type of collaboration is occurring between Twinfield and Cabot?
3. How much is still owing on the CSPAC building?
4. Are there other school districts besides Twinfield that we could collaborate with?

The board asked for volunteers for the Facilities Committee, which would be tasked with working through the recent facilities report and making decisions about the campus.

It was noted there are three seats up for election to the school board.

It was suggested that charts and graphs be incorporated into the power point presentation for the School Meeting on Monday, March 5, 2012, in the school gym.

It was noted the \$54,000 listed as "School Board" was a placeholder for possible increases in supervisory union costs due to higher assessments. These assessments won't be clear until after contract negotiations are completed.
